

Airtricity wins Green Energy Supply Award at Inaugural Green Awards 2008

At the Inaugural Green Energy awards ceremony in the Burlington hotel on 4th December last, Airtricity were awarded the prestigious Green Energy Supply Award at the inaugural 2008 Green Awards 2008.
